- 2023-2024 Audit review for approval: David Farnsworth presented the review of the 2023-2024 Audit. David determined the audit to be clean. Vicky Bosworth moved to accept the 2023 2024 audit as presented. Motion seconded by Sue Fitzpatrick. Unanimous.
- 2) <u>Discuss Five Star Bank proposal:</u> The Board the discussed the details of the proposal of Five Star Bank. No action taken.
- 3) Review and discuss progress of the Lomita property repairs and improvement: Steve Albright reported the garage doors have been replaced. The roof, rain gutters, deck and sliding glass door have been repaired. Steve presented a bid from JD Trenching to remove the pool and return with fill. JD Trenching also submitted a bid to install a gate between the properties. No action taken.
- 4) <u>Discuss Block 76 development and approve architect:</u> The Board discussed the development of Block 76. Steve Albright presented a contract with EDA Land Planning to design and draw plans. Norman Koepernik moved to sign the contract with EDA as presented. Vicky Bosworth seconded the motion. Unanimous.
- 5) <u>Discuss Block 75 and 76 designs:</u> Steve Albright presented a layout of block 75 and 76 detailing burial plots, cremation garden location and the proposed roads. Norman Koepernik presented a design layout for 9 small columbariums. The Board approved sending both layouts to EDA Land Planning as a design reference.
- **6)** <u>Discuss BMO signature cards:</u> Steve Albright reported he had received an email from BMO stating the Board would be receiving a new Signature packet to complete.
- 7) Review bids and approve manager's house bathroom remodel: Steve Albright presented a bid summary for the remodel of the bathroom in the manager's house. The summary contained four bids. Vicky Bosworth moved to accept the bid from Gonzalo Ortiz construction as presented. Motion seconded by Sue Fitzpatrick. Unanimous.
